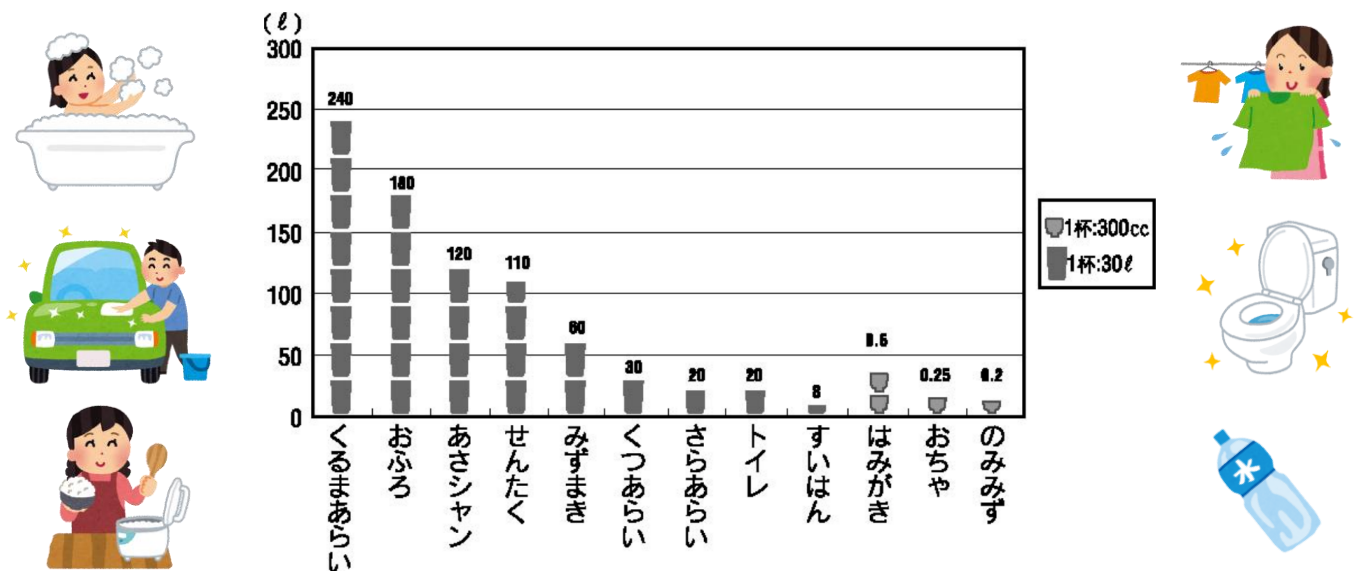


まいにちのみず
